The barrier provides a greater level of comfort for drivers coming to work because it follows social distancing protocols and the CDC's guidelines for mass transit.

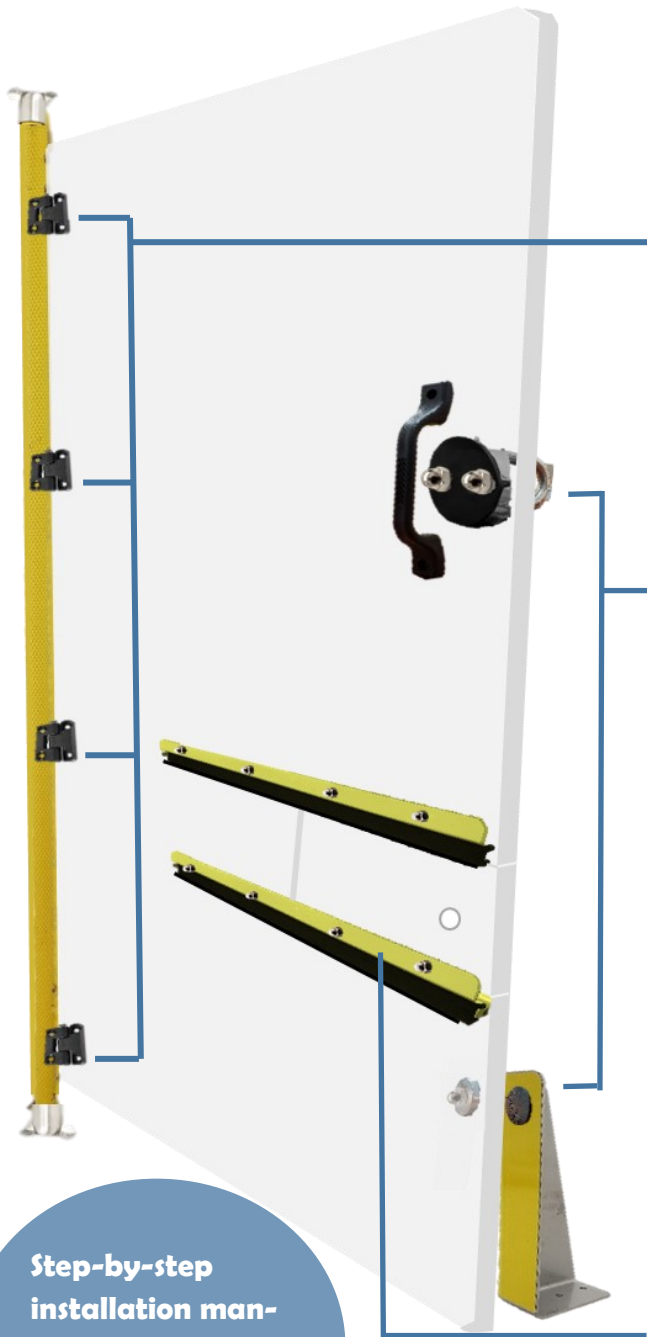


Maintain Ridership Levels

Secondary Escape Route

The hinged door is a safety feature that allows the driver a secondary escape route if the bus were ever in an accident that blocked the driver's door.

Quiet Ride

The loop holder and magnet secure the door in place and keep it from vibrating as the bus is in motion, providing a quiet ride.

No Maintenance Required

The barrier is constructed out of high quality materials that won't break down or require maintenance and could remain on the bus for many years to come.

Complete Protection

The barrier completely covers the driver's cab. For buses with a manual door control, the sliding window allows for operation while also giving maximum protection.

Barriers for Every Bus

Farebox

Ideal for buses with fare boxes mounted to the entry stanchion.



Standard

Ideal for buses with automatic door controls and no fare box.



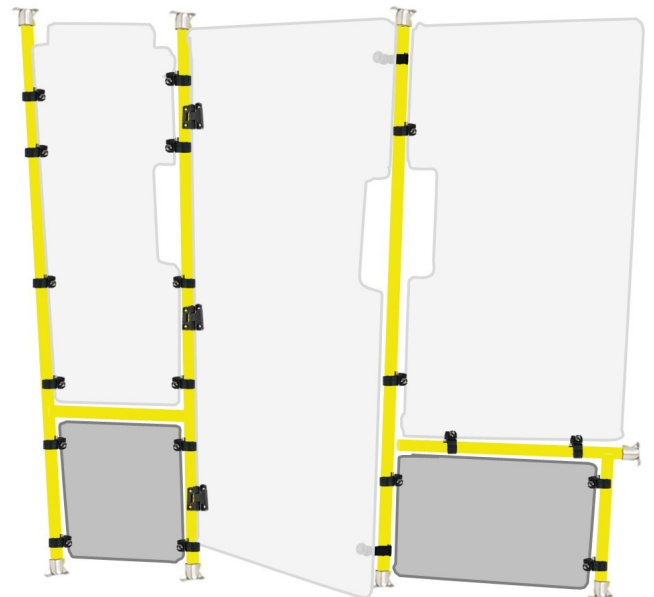
Window Slider

Ideal for buses with manual door controls or for easy access to the driver cab.



Front Divider

Ideal for transit operators who want to keep the front of the bus separated from the back.
